

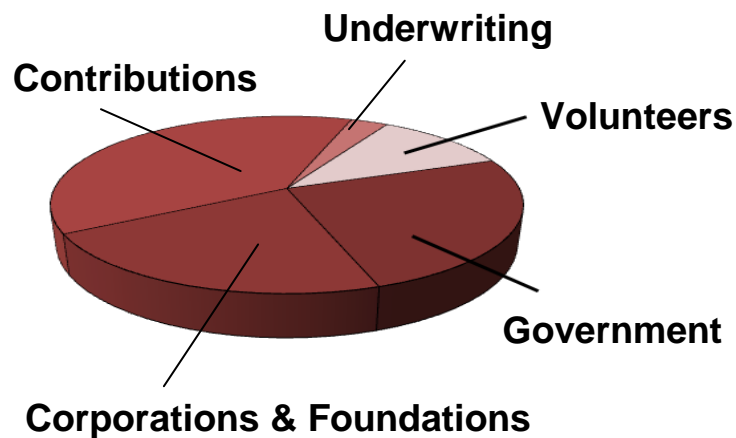
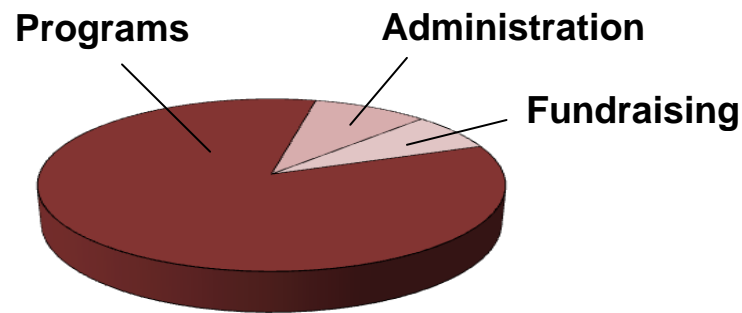
2012 – AN EXTRAORDINARY YEAR

In 2012, IRIS enjoyed growth in every area with new listeners, volunteers and services. Our signal extended farther than ever, reaching new listeners in places like Britt and Bettendorf for the first time. IRIS volunteers produced over 4,000 hours of live and recorded spoken material from 7 locations around the state. Blind patrons experienced the thrill of live musical theater through our new audio description services – performed during 6 Broadway productions through the Civic Center at Des Moines Performing Arts. 2012 saw the final dollars of the federal support that have sustained us for so long. We tightened our belts, pared our budget and identified new ways to do more with less. Our renewed focus on outreach and fundraising started to produce results with \$5,730 raised from our December Newsletter alone.

We are so grateful to all the IRIS volunteers, listeners, friends and contributors that helped make 2012 extraordinary for IRIS. Together, we will continue to survive – and thrive – in 2013!
