Our 35th Year!

August 21, we will begin our 35th year on the air. What started as a handful of volunteers reading to a few hundred listeners in Des Moines has grown to hundreds of volunteers serving listeners in every corner of the state! We read 10 lowa newspapers and deliver equal access to the arts in communities from the Missouri to the Mississippi. We have uploaded 13,000 podcast episodes since July 2019. Listeners have downloaded 266,300 times in that same period.

Our Audio Description Services have grown beyond theaters to include events like the State Fair, ball games, exhibits and haunted houses. In this AI world, the preference for our human voices only gets stronger so does IRIS. NONE of this is possible without our volunteers, donors, sponsors and partners. THANK YOU!



Her daily dedication to our listeners makes her a hero in our eyes. We asked Grace to share a little information about herself with you:

"In my earlier years, I attended the University of Wisconsin-Madison majoring in Ag Journalism and Dairy Science. I always enjoyed editing things. My husband, Tom, and I moved to Iowa as our honeymoon as he had a job involving grain bin dryer repair and you don't get a vacation during harvest time! We are celebrating our 45th wedding anniversary in September.

I later received an Associate degree in accounting. In the meantime, I helped area dairy farmers milk cows (or goats) for 40 years. I was a rural mail carrier for 15 years. I play piano at church and was the church financial secretary and sang with Sweet Adelines for 30 years. I resumed playing the viola after a hiatus from high school and am now playing in some area community orchestras. I did all of this while being the business end (my husband was the technical end) of Kesley Electric, Inc.; sales & service of electric motors.
